Not directly related to PP but action previously agreed by PC to progress - linked to Parks and Green Spaces are improved. Potential S106 monies to replace those in poor condition.	Map location and access condition of all park benches in the Parish. (Those owned by WRPC already mapped – but photograph and condition report needed.) Report any concerns of restricted access to any bench – e.g surrounding area overgrown in summer to appropriate DCC officer	Dec 2018
3 Improve footpaths and paving	Identify priorities for urgent repairs or improving access where dropped curbs are required	Dec 2018
	Identify/Map all public footpaths and right of way from DCC definitive	Oct – for initial identification then on-going

2. Litter, fly tipping and dog fouling is reduced	Work with local business to gain support for helping to deal with litter and mess arising outside their business premises	Dec 2018
9C Improved Road Safety	Act as Community Speed Check Co-ordinator	On Going
9 E Improved Road Safety	Ensure signage is not overgrown in summer and report any concerns to DCC	On going April – October?
9 G Improved Road Safety	Map location of all existing DCC salt bins, ensure residents know their location and where to report any concerns (Village News – PC website) Monitor salt levels in winter and assist in dispersing if needed.	October – then on going
